BYLAW NO. 2717

**A Bylaw to Assess and Levy the Cost of Fire Prevention, Suppression and
Emergency Response Services**

The Council of the Town of Carlyle, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw:
 - a) "Municipality" means the Town of Carlyle;
 - b) "Service Provider" means the Carlyle & RM #63 Fire Protection Board.
2. Fire suppression and/or prevention services and emergency rescue services shall be delivered on behalf of the Municipality by the service provider, as provided in Bylaw 1/93.
3. Fees relative to the services identified in Section 2 of this bylaw shall be established by the Service Provider in accordance with the terms of the agreement entered into by the Municipality.
4. The Service Provider shall charge the cost of the fire prevention, suppression services and emergency rescue services directly to the person or persons who receive the service.
5. At the request of the Service Provider, if all or a portion of the charge noted in Section 4 of this bylaw remains unpaid at the end of the calendar year or ninety (90) days after the person invoiced for said services, whichever is earlier, the Municipality may add the amount owing to the taxes on any parcel of land owned by the person.
6. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the 1st day of January, 2008.
